## Internship and requirements at Wale Wale Kenya

Wale Wale Kenya is a Kenyan NGO that has been working with young people in Nairobi for almost ten years. Our mission is to provide tools for young people with which they can build a future. One of the, if not the most important, tool in this process is education, but not only the education taught in school. The awareness of ones rights and value and the confidence to trust ones capabilities are to us other crucial aspects of education. Since the beginning of 2013, Wale Wale Kenya runs a Youth Center in one of the largest slum areas in Africa – Kibera. In 2016 we have a close collaboration together with the French Embassy of Kenya, for this we need help with writing well composed reports and evaluate the different projects. Throughout your internship you will be in close contact with our youths in the everyday work at the center. In other words, the internship puts demands on your theoretical skills as well as your practical and interpersonal skills. We welcome interns all year round for 1 month minimum up to 12 months maximum.

We welcome students in the end of their university education or with skills that in a clear way would contribute to our organisation. Experience from social work or work in other organisations is an advantage but not necessary.
