DIVA

The digital science archive, DIVA, is a publishing tool used for electronic registration, publication and archiving of publications from different universitites.

Once your thesis is published it will become searchable in DIVA and via search engines such as Google and the library system Libris. Others will then be able to read your work.

You can search the Stockholm University DIVA here

In order to register your thesis, you <u>log onto the DIVA platform</u> using your university account and password.

Registering your work in DIVA in 4 steps as follows:

Step 1

Choose publication type: Student thesis.

Step 2

Fill in your details and the details about the thesis (Only field marked with a red asterisk are obligatory).

Some clarifications:

- Number of pages: Set the number of the last numbered page in your thesis
- Identifiers: Skip
- National subject category: Social Sciences Sociology Social Anthropology
- Supervisor/Examiner: Please add the name and department
- Presentation: Leave empty

Step 3

Upload your file in a PDF format and make freely available now (open access). This option also includes digital archiving of your thesis in DIVA.

Step 4

Review/Publish: Make sure the information you have filled in is correct. If you want to change something, simply click on *Edit information* or *Back*. When everything seems correct, *Submit* your thesis to DIVA.

Once you have registered your thesis in DIVA and submitted it, it will be sent to an administrator at the responsible department before it is published. You will therefor not be able to search for it immediately after submitting.
